Alecia Beth Moore (born September 8, 1979), better known by her stage name Pink (stylized as P!nk), is an American singer-songwriter, musician and actress.

Originally a member of the girl group Choice, Pink began her solo **career** with her first single, "There You Go" of her debut album, *Can't Take Me Home* in 2000.

Pink has become one of the most successful artists, having sold over 40 million albums and 70 million singles across the **globe**, as of January 2012. She holds three Grammy Awards.

On September 13, 2009, Pink performed "Sober" while doing a trapeze act at the MTV Video Music Awards, where she was nominated for Best Female Video. On January 31, 2010, Pink did another trapeze act in the form of aerial silks at the 2010 Grammy Awards, this time performing the song "Glitter in the Air". She received a standing **ovation**.

Pink has named Janis Joplin as her biggest musical **influence** saying: "She was so inspiring by singing blues music when it wasn't culturally acceptable for white women, and she wore her heart on her sleeve. She was so witty and charming and intelligent, but she also battled an ugly-duckling syndrome. I would love to play her in a movie.
