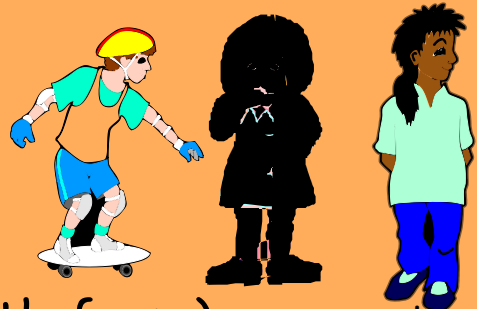
nursery school - 3 - not compulsory

secondary school - 16 - 17 - (sixth form) not compulsory



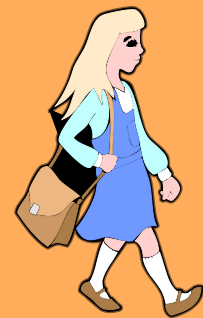
Everybody studies English, maths and science up to the age of 16.
