Canada

Canada /ˈkænədə/ is a North American country consisting of ten provinces and three territories. It is the world's second-largest country by total area, and its common border with the United States is the world's longest land border shared by the same two countries. Its capital is Otawa but the largest city is Toronto. The flag consists of free stripes -2 red and one white, in the middle there is a symbol of the country, a red maple leaf.

Canada is a federal state governed as a parliamentary democracy and a constitutional monarchy, with Queen Elizabeth II as its head of state. The country is officially bilingual and multicultural at the federal level, with a population of approximately 35 million as of 2013.

Canada's two official languages are Canadian English and Canadian French. More than 85 percent of French-speaking Canadians live in Quebec.

Canada is famous for the sport achievements, especially in hockey. Thanks to its climate it is ideal for wide range of winter sports. The country has held the winter Olympic games twice – in 1988 in Calgary, in 2010 in Vancouver.

Canadian city Toronto has a significant number of Czech immigrants living there, among them there was also a Czech writer and publisher Josef Škvorecký who was famous especially by the book "Tankový prapor.
