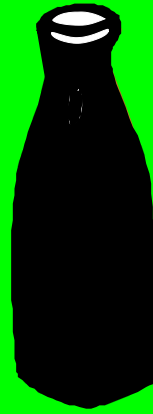

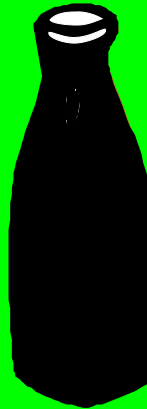

What meals do you associate with the United Kingdom?

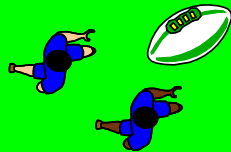
- gravy – brown sauce, eaten with chips and ham
